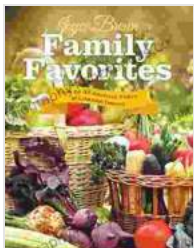


# From An All American Family Of Lebanese Descent: A Memoir of Identity, Culture, and Belonging

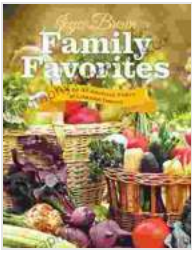

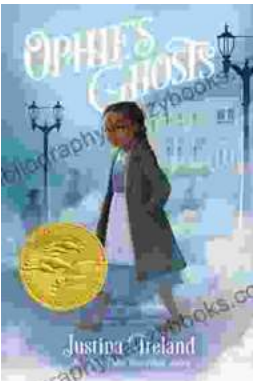

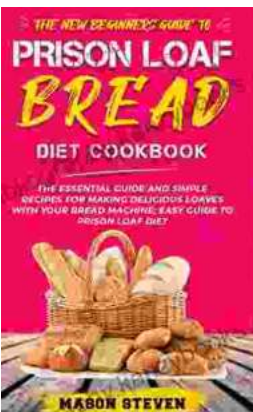
