

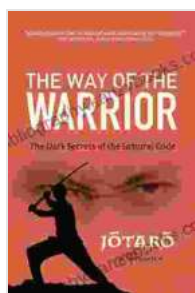

(1975), Tai-Pan (1986), and Noble House (1988). Clavell died in 1994 at the age of 70.

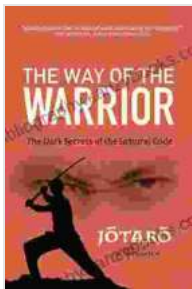

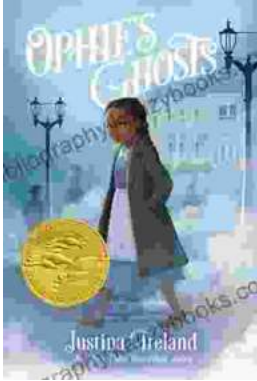

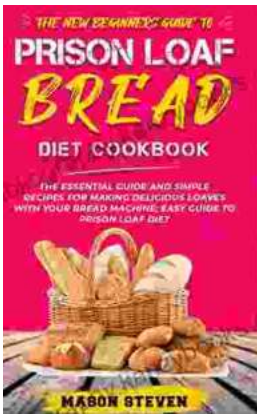
